PROM 2018: MARCH 17, 8:00-11:00 P.M., TREASURES, LAKE CHARLES

- Only students in grades 9-12 will be allowed to attend prom.
- Age Limit is 19 yrs. old (see pg 29 of handbook)
- All guests must be signed up **by deadline** and any person that is not a student of SBHS will be asked to provide a copy of a school id or driver's license.
- Criminal background checks may be completed on anyone signed up to attend the prom
- All student fees, carnival debt, and ID debt must be paid prior to attending prom.
- Juniors will vote on the theme of the prom—Knight of a Thousand Lights, Blue, Black, Gold, Silver
- Tradition that Senior girls wear white dresses, however, we cannot tell juniors that you cannot buy a white dress but just know that you should respect tradition and you will be a senior the next year
- There will be several officers and Mr. Bartz and Mrs. Martin greeting you at the door checking for intoxication and/or drug use.
- Once you enter the prom you cannot leave and return. Everyone must sign in and sign out
- Seniors will be introduced at 9:00 PM followed by the crowning of the King and Queen (You must be present to be awarded Prom Queen and/or King). Photo Booth will be available from 8:30-10:30.
- No provocative or offensive dancing
- No canes or confetti (Treasure's Rule)
- No kissing or PDA (Public Display of Affection)

Girls

Allowed: Strapless formal dresses, spaghetti type straps, backless formal dresses (SIDES MUST BE COVERED), tea length/short formal party dresses

NOT ALLOWED: Low cut fronts (ladies make sure the dress style fits your body type), bare midriffs, **body cut outs of any kind**, skirt slits passed mid-thigh, **see-through fabric or netting above the thigh**, no slacks or pant suits. WE WILL NOT HELP YOU ALTER A DRESS AT THE DOOR—NO SAFETY PIN OR VELCRO SESSIONS THIS YEAR. YOU WILL BE INSTRUCTED TO LEAVE AND ONLY RETURN IF YOU & DATE ARE IN DRESS CODE. DRESS MAY NOT BE COVERED WITH JACKET TO SLIP THROUGH DRESS CODE. BE RESPONSIBLE.

Boys

Allowed: Suit or tuxedo with shirt and tie or sports coat with dress slacks/ shirt and tie

Not Allowed: No jeans (OF ANY COLOR) formal attire must be worn at all times

Non-SBHS Dates: All dress code/behavior rules apply. It is your responsibility to inform your date.

NEW Dress Code: 2018

Boys: Dress slacks or uniform pants (NO JEANS of any color). Long sleeve, button-up shirt with tie. Dress shoes or boots. No tennis shoes.

Girls: Dress slacks or uniform pants. Dressy blouse. Dress shoes or boots. No tennis shoes. Dress is allowed ONLY if it is floor length and dressy, Sunday-type dress. No dresses of any other length allowed.
